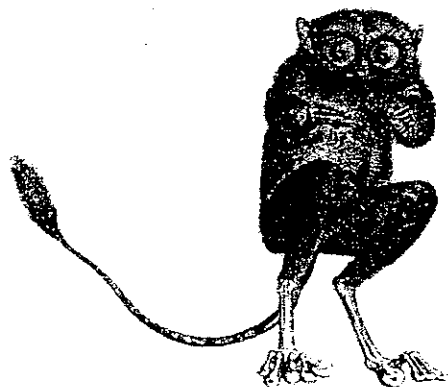
Section G: Comprehension (10 marks)
